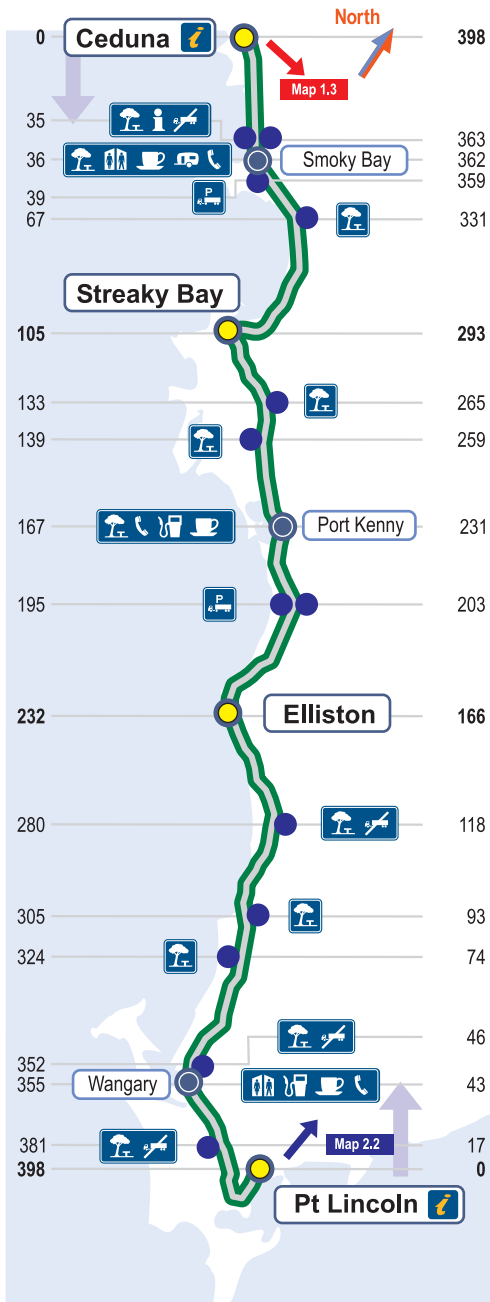


## 2.1: Flinders Highway

B100: Ceduna to Port Lincoln

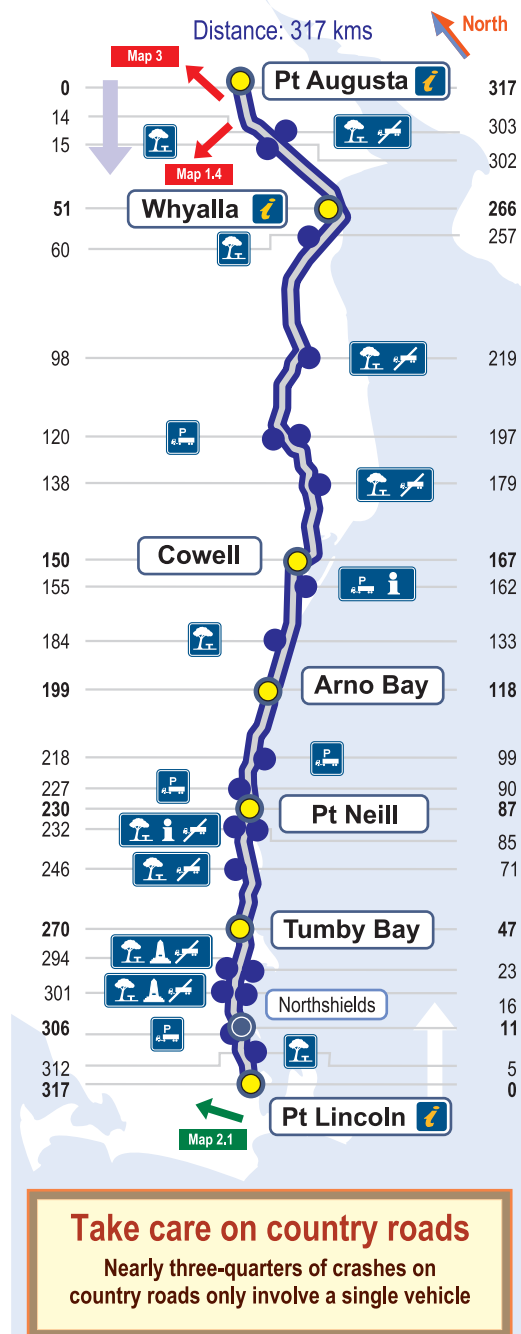
Distance: 398 kms

**Take care on country roads**

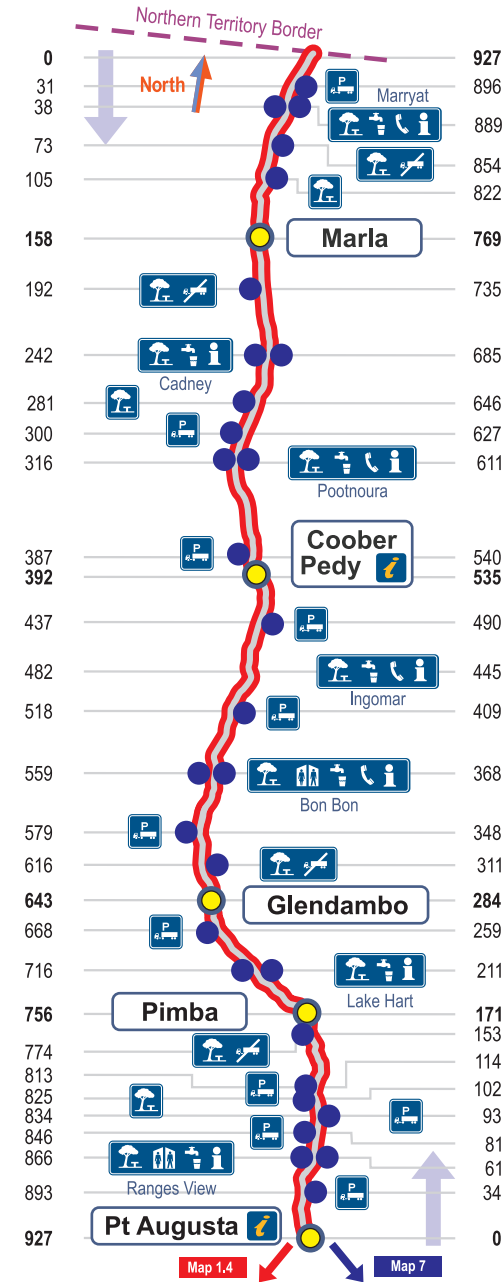
Nearly three-quarters of crashes on country roads only involve a single vehicle

**International Visitors ... please take special care on country roads**

Crashes involving international visitors tend to occur in rural areas and are often more severe than crashes involving local road users.

Most of our visitors come from countries which drive on the same side of the road as we do but almost one third are accustomed to driving on the right.
